

# Defining the placement for a modification

The [placement](#) determines where on the web page the modification is placed. In the page code, the modification is always placed in relation to a specific target element. How and where the modification is actually available on the page depends on the page layout.

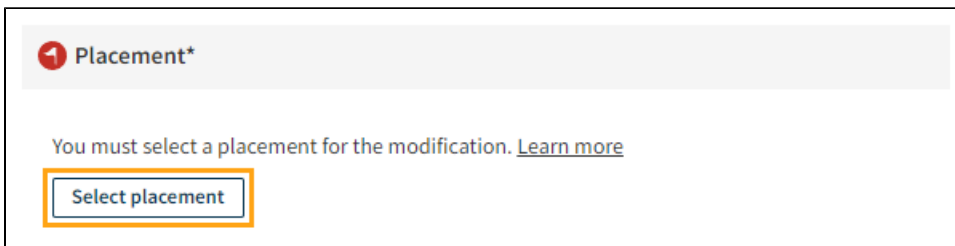

## Selecting the placement

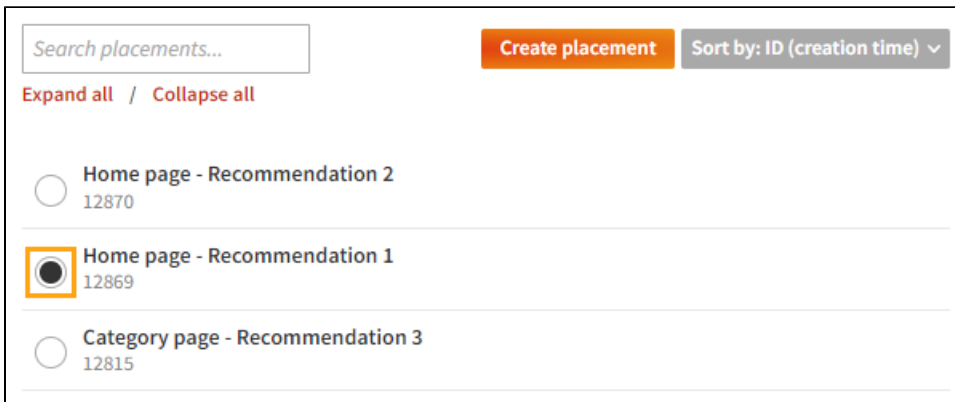
You can either select an existing placement, or create and select a new placement. You can only select one placement for a modification.

To select the placement:

1. In the Frosmo Control Panel, in the sidebar, select **Modifications**.
2. In the modifications list, [find the modification](#) whose placement you want to select, and click the modification name.
3. In the **Basic settings** view, in the **Placement** section, click **Select placement**.



4. Select an existing placement, or create and select a new placement by clicking **Create placement**. For instructions on how to create a placement, see [Creating and editing a placement](#).



5. When you're done, click **Save**.

## Changing the placement

To change the selected placement:

1. In the Frosmo Control Panel, in the sidebar, select **Modifications**.
2. In the modifications list, [find the modification](#) whose placement you want to change, and click the modification name.
3. In the **Basic settings** view, in the **Placement** section, click **Select placement**.
4. Select another existing placement, or create and select a new placement by clicking **Create placement**. For instructions on how to create a placement, see [Creating and editing a placement](#).
5. When you're done, click **Save**.
